- Background:** The Minority Men's Network Educational Foundation, a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization, awards one or more scholarships annually in the name of the late Mr. Ron Marley who made the first contribution to the scholarship fund. The inaugural year was 2003.
- Amount of Award:** \$2000
- Eligibility:** African-American high school seniors with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher; Boone County resident; accepted for admission to an **ACCREDITED POST-SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OR PROGRAM**. The successful applicant must demonstrate leadership and be involved in school/community activities. Applicants may also be evaluated on the basis of need.

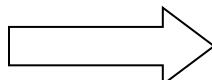
